BACKGROUND

The project aims to reduce noise levels to residences of the Long Acres neighborhood along a portion of I-295 Southbound. Peak highway traffic noise levels

approach or exceed the recommended threshold for residential noise in this area. The neighborhood is bounded by W. Long Drive to the west, Route 206 to the east, and Rider University to the south.

THE PROPOSED PROJECT

The Preliminary Preferred Alternative (PPA) for the project is a 2,780-foot-long concrete noise barrier.

TRAFFIC CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

Construction will occur in a single stage along the shoulders, median of I-295, and ramp infields. While off-peak hour ramp detours are expected for most ramps, the I-295 Southbound to Route 206 Southbound ramp will be completely closed with a detour to construct the noise barrier. All other lanes and ramps will remain open during peak hours.
